## 2.6.1 Programme and course outcomes for all Programmes offered by the institution are stated and displayed on website and communicated to teachers and students.

The Programme Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs) of each Programme and Course that the Institute offers determine the academic learning value.

In order to align with the objectives of each programme as well as the institution's vision, mission, and quality policy, the institute established its POs and COs with an idealistic perspective.

Course outcomes are succinct descriptions of the fundamental information that students need to acquire and the level of learning that is anticipated at the end of the course. The institution offers a variety of programmes that are tailored to the needs of students' career possibilities as determined by the university.

The main goal of the course and programme outcomes is to improve students' knowledge and abilities, which are essential for developing their potential and personalities. Additionally, emphasis is placed on the holistic growth of pupils via the teaching of morals and values as well as the enhancement of their communication and interpersonal skills through learning outcomes. After consulting with subject matter experts, the POs, COs, and PSOs are ready for all UG and PG programmes. To write them, the whole faculty convened for brainstorming sessions. At the start of the academic year, lesson plans are created including the course objectives, course outcomes, teaching resources, and total number of teaching hours. All course COs are first submitted to the IQAC for approval before being put up on the notice boards. Every IQAC meeting includes a discussion on the significance of POs and COs. The college's vision, mission, values, and goals are prominently displayed at the entryway to clearly communicate the college's viewpoints.

All of the institute's programmes have a vision, mission, programme outcomes (POs), programme specific outcomes (PSOs), and course outcomes (COs) that are listed, uploaded, and shared with all of the staff and students on the college. Employees who have just been hired are given a briefing about the course and programme outcomes. They are given an explanation of POs, PSOs, and COs after the assignment of the appropriate courses. Each faculty member gives the students an overview of the course curriculum and expectations at the start of each semester. Copies of the syllabus are stored at the departments' various labs, libraries, and offices. All parties involved, including students and staff, have access to them. During the Orientation Programme at the start of the school year, parents and children get information on POs, PSOs, and COs. The faculty is able to concentrate on the achievement of these goals when student assessments are conducted against this background, which enhances the effectiveness of the teaching-learning process.



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
