The courses that the institution has established demonstrate the many ways in which it has integrated gender equality and awareness into the curriculum. For example, the College provides a course called "Gender Sensitization" that aims to enlighten students on certain important biological characteristics of gender as well as more equal interactions between males and girls.

The institution encourages gender awareness via extracurricular events including workshops, seminars, guest lectures, street performances, poster displays, counselling, and so forth. For its female pupils, the college provided "self-defence training". To protect female students and workers, frequent awareness programmes are held on issues including the value of human rights, women's rights in home circumstances, and cyber security.

In compliance with the criteria of the university grievance committee, the following committees were created by the institution: the mentorship programme, women's empowerment, the anti-ragging committee, the students' disciplinary committee, and the welfare committee for SC/ST students. The institution's website provides a comprehensive overview of the duties of these committees, and orientation and induction events provide students with further details.

Employees and students at the institution have access to safety and security facilities including CCTV monitoring around the campus and round-the-clock security guards. To support students' academic, emotional, social, and cognitive growth, the school offers a specialised counselling service and a successful mentorship programme. There are many ways that students might obtain individual counselling. The restrooms for men and women are housed in separate buildings. There are sanitary napkin dispensing machines in the restrooms to ensure your safety. The facility also provides separate, luxurious communal areas for men and women.

The institution celebrates national holidays and the birthdays of famous Indian people every year in an effort to instil values and patriotism among its pupils. The flag-raising ceremony, project exhibits, poster presentations, excursions, essay writing, and elocution are all part of the celebrations. Prominent individuals are asked to provide inspirational talks to faculty and students on these days.

Every year, the institution observes many national and international holidays, such as Gandhi Jayanthi, Republic Day, International Yoga Day, Teachers Day, World Pharmacy Day, Woman's Day, and Independence Day.



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
